**SUBJECT: INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM**

WHEREAS, terrorist acts have caused strife between the nations of the world and have caused distress and unrest in not only the nation of Algeria but around the globe, and

WHEREAS, in Algeria terrorist organizations such as the “Armed Islamic Group”, or “GIA”, are directly linked to the major terrorist party, al-Qaeda, and

WHEREAS, these terrorist groups attack not only in Africa and the Middle East, but in other countries such as the United States of America, Indonesia, Spain, and the United Kingdom, and

WHEREAS, militants have killed thousands of people in Algeria, the numbers of dead outside of Algeria are stunning, and

WHEREAS, the terrorist groups of GIA and al-Qaeda are connected, and

WHEREAS, the GIA have killed over 400 innocent Algerians in 1998, and

WHEREAS, the GIA also claim responsibility for the attack, also in 1998, that killed forty innocents 100 kilometers south of Algeria, and

WHEREAS, if allowed to continue with these attacks, they may cause numerous other deaths around the world, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, we propose that a committee be formed to investigate and eventually disrupt links between terrorist groups and therefore, in time, destroy said groups, this committee will be called the “United Nations Against Terrorist Acts”, or UNATA, UNATA will find and disrupt links between GIA and al-Qaeda, better and more uniformly distribute information to all nations to better educate them about terrorism, improve border patrols to keep terrorist from moving to other countries, and request military assistance when required.
